# Opioid and Suicide Loss in the Behavioral Health Workplace

## **Presented by NYS OASAS**

### **Training Description:**

This training will address traumatic loss and its impact on the behavioral health workforce, including overdose and suicide statistics, risk factors, and risk management measures, prevention and postvention protocols, grief and loss, vicarious traumatization and burnout, and clinician self-care.

#### The objectives are:

- To increase understanding and awareness of the impact of suicide and overdose on clients, families, and behavioral health staff.
- To list responses to risk factors for clinicians and clients. Describe and apply prevention and post-vention protocols.
- To learn to respond to vicarious traumatization and burnout individually, and as a clinician.
- To provide and list strategies and resources for counselor self-care.

Six (6) OASAS clock hours are approved for application to the Credentialed Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counselor credential (CASAC Renewal only), OASAS Credentialed Prevention Professional/Credentialed Prevention Specialist (CPP/CPS Initial Section 1, and Renewal). Social Work CEU's are approved for 6 hours.
