

Travel Instructions

By car

Take Grand Central Parkway East to Exit 23, Alley Pond Park, make a right on Winchester Boulevard, keep straight and continue across the light at Union Turnpike. At the next light, make a left turn into the facility grounds and keep to your right. At the first STOP sign, make a right turn, then keep straight until you arrive at the first entrance on the right. Enter the grounds and make a right turn and keep going all the way around past the daycare center, which is the second building. Creedmoor ATC is the next building. There is a sign in front that reads Creedmoor ATC Building #19.

By Public Transportation

Take the “F” Train to 179th Street, last stop, and then the Q43 bus East to Hillside Avenue to Winchester Boulevard. You can also take the “E” Train to Union Turnpike, then the Q46 A bus East on Union Turnpike to Winchester Boulevard.

Creedmoor Addiction Treatment Center is a 26-bed, short-term residential addiction rehabilitation program that is medically supervised and staffed by a multidisciplinary treatment team.

Individualized treatment planning addresses all aspects of personal recovery.

SERVICES INCLUDE

- Individual Counseling
- Group Counseling
- Family Counseling
- Comprehensive Client Education
- Medical, Psychiatric and Psychosocial Intervention
- Activity Therapy Program
- Anonymous Self Help Groups

Participation in all aspects of the program is required.

SPECIAL POPULATIONS SERVED

- Addicted Women
- Homeless Men
- Individuals on medication assisted treatment

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Services are available to individuals who are in need of residential care for addiction and reside in the county of Queens.

THE INDIVIDUAL

- Appears to be in need of inpatient chemical dependency services
- Appears not to be in need of a higher level of care
- Is unable to participate in or comply with treatment outside of a 24-hour structured treatment setting based on one or more of the following:
 - Failure at a less intensive level of care
 - A living environment not conducive to recovery
 - Physical or mental complications and co-morbidities requiring medical management
 - A lack of judgment, insights, and motivation such as to require 24-hour supervision
 - Able to climb stairs without assistance
- Final admission decisions are always made by the ATC Medical Director

PAYMENT

Medicaid and other third party insurance accepted. Sliding scale fees based on eligibility to pay.

No individual will be denied service due to financial situation.

VISITING

Visiting and phone calls are encouraged during designated hours. Visitors must observe our policy of providing an alcohol and drug-free setting.
