



Approved Human Services Degrees

If you are a CASAC, or CPP/CPS applicant who holds an Associate's, Bachelor's or Master's Degree in an approved Human Services field, or are a student pursuing any of these degrees, some of the course work associated with your degree may be claimed toward satisfying some or all of the CASAC or CPP/CPS education and training requirements. In order to determine what coursework may be applicable, your college transcript(s) should be submitted with your application.

In addition, if you hold a degree in an approved Human Services field, you may be able to substitute your degree for a portion of work experience.
