

CPGC REINSTATEMENT MANDATORY TRAININGS

To Reinstate a CPGC credential that has been expired for longer than one year, 75 hours of trainings must be completed. The 54 hours of training listed below are mandatory. The remaining 21 hours can be any training that relates to problem gambling counseling and meets the OASAS training standards as outlined in the Reinstatement Application. For the majority of the trainings, a certificate can be obtained through the OASAS answerkey portal (<https://answerkey.net/oasas/>) by taking a test for each training completed. The trainings marked with an asterisk (*) indicate that they are not through the OASAS answerkey portal and a certificate will be provided by the training provider's website.
