



OASAS Substance Use Disorder Education and Recovery Fund Legislative Report

This report is prepared and submitted in accordance with Section 19.45 of the Mental Hygiene Law, regarding the Substance Use Disorder Education and Recovery Fund, which directs the Office of Addiction Services and Supports (OASAS) to report to:

the temporary president of the senate, speaker of the assembly, chair of the senate finance committee, chair of the assembly ways and means committee, chair of the senate committee on mental health and developmental disabilities, and chair of the assembly mental health committee.

Such report shall include how the monies of the substance use disorder education and recovery fund were utilized during the proceeding calendar year and shall include:

- (1) the amount of money dispersed from the fund;*
- (2) recipients of awards from the fund;*
- (3) the amount awarded to each recipient; and*
- (4) the purposes for which such awards were granted.*

The first deposit was made into this account in January 2022. The balance as of December 31, 2023 was \$92,447.42, an increase of \$38,318.54 from December 31, 2022. No awards or disbursements were made from the fund during Calendar Year 2023.
