Subject: Status Update of OASAS Part 822 Comprehensive Outpatient Treatment Program (COP)

Dear Plan Representative

- On May 28, 2024, plans received the attached memorandum regarding New York State Office of Addiction Support Services (OASAS) implementation of Comprehensive Outpatient Treatment Programs (COP).
The May memorandum gave a brief overview of the COP initiative and indicated that OASAS would be providing plans with:
1. COP rate code and reimbursement information necessary for plans to configured COPs programs in the plans claiming / contract system(s).
2. A list of Comprehensive Outpatient Treatment Programs (COP).

Item One: Rate Code and Reimbursement Amounts:

- OASAS is directing programs to transition to the COPs rates codes as soon as possible after the August 1, 2024, effective date.
OASAS expects that all programs will be utilizing the COP rate codes and all plans paying on the COP rate codes by November 1, 2024.
Plans are requested to reach out to programs to begin the process of updating the providers claims configuration to add the COPs rate codes.

Please review the COP list against the plan's current network of OASAS Outpatient Clinic and / or Opioid Treatment Programs and their associated contracts / claims configurations. At a minimum the configuration and contracts should be updated to reflect COP rate codes / reimbursement amounts.
