TRAVEL ADVISORY:

Requirement to Quarantine for Travel to States with Prevalent Transmission of COVID-19

Summary

This advisory is to implement Executive Order 205.

Current Situation

As COVID-19 transmission has reached a very low level in New York, vigilance must be maintained to ensure that New York does not see a surge from states with increasing community transmission of COVID-19.

Based upon Governor Cuomo's Executive Order 205, issued June 25, 2020, the following states meet the criteria for required quarantine:

- Alabama
- Arkansas
- Arizona
- Florida
- North Carolina
- South Carolina
- Texas
- Utah

This is based upon a seven day rolling average, of positive tests in excess of 10%, or number of positive cases exceeding 10 per 100,000 residents.

Quarantine and any exemptions will be addressed by guidance, found here. This Travel Advisory will be updated as needed to address changing public health metrics.
